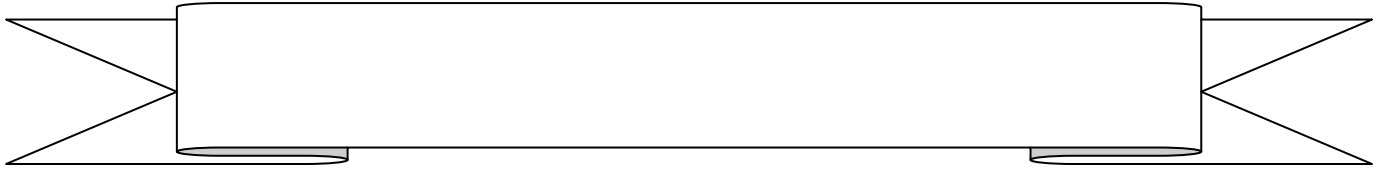

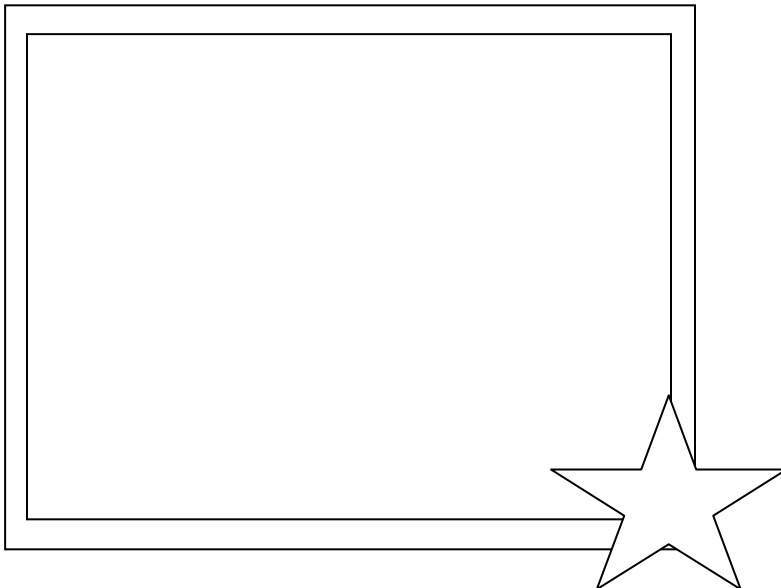

CCYO TENNIS 2022

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION. The Celtic Catholic Youth Organization (CCYO) Middle School Tennis Program's spring season starts this March. This will be the fifth season of CCYO Tennis, which promotes competitive tennis play for all CGSAA member schools with other private and public middle schools in the OKC metro area. We will play approximately 6-8 duals held after school hours on weekdays from late March through April. In addition, CCYO tennis players will be eligible to play in the OTCA Individual Tennis Championships held in Tulsa on the last week of April.

FEES. There will be a fee for participation that will be around \$20 and will be discussed once the season begins. Team t-shirts will be available for order and purchase at start of the season but are not mandatory. Players are encouraged to bring a can of balls to matches but only expect to use about 2-3 cans for the whole season since they can be re-used (approximately \$3/can at most stores). Players that choose to play in the OTCA Championships will be responsible for their own transportation and entry fee (\$20 per player).

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY. All middle school students grades 6-8 that attend CGSAA member schools are welcome to participate. It is recommended that players have some prior tennis instruction and match experience and preferably USTA junior tournament experience. Line-ups will be determined by the CCYO Coaches with the goal to provide as competitive a match as possible without overwhelming any player.

Although the players will be competing individually or with a partner, we are a team, and we expect players to stay and watch their teammates compete, even if the individual players have completed their own match play. Players should wear a CCYO Tennis shirt or other t-shirt and sport shorts/skirts with pockets. We request that players do not wear their school uniforms to compete. During matches, players will receive coaching from the CCYO tennis coaches. Parents/spectators should not coach players during match play. Practices will likely occur on the weekends beginning in February.
