





Session 1: June 1—5 VBS/Helping Our CK Community

All children who enroll for this week will be attending VBS. You will sign them up and pay for it at the time of registration. VBS is a camp this year from 9am to Noon each day. Registration for VBS is available on the church website. The cost for before and after care is \$180.00 per child. Checks for before and after care must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB and given to KIDS CLUB staff.

Session 2: June 8—12 CK News

All children who enroll this week will be attending CK News Camp with Mrs. Cheek. All of you will have the opportunity to watch the weekly broadcasts of our own CK NEWS. Our campers will spend the week compiling a SUMMER broadcast of the CK NEWS. Students will film news stories while learning how to use our equipment. They will host a "magazine style" news program. 
