# PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE



March 3, 2026

Dear Knights:

The Parental Choice Tax Credit application window opens on March 16, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.

We are in the process of submitting information to generate Enrollment Verification Numbers (EVN) for our families who have enrolled at CK for the 2026-2027 school year. An Enrollment Verification Number (EVN) is required for each student for whom you plan to apply for the Parental Choice Tax Credit for the 2026-2027 school year. Please be checking your email for this important information. If any information is incorrect when you receive your EVN, please contact the school immediately so that we can remedy the problem.

Please see helpful information below related to the PCTC, which opens on March 16th at 9:00 a.m.

**Q: Where is the application link?**

**A:** You will apply at this link: [https://oktap.tax.ok.gov/oktap/Web/\\_/](https://oktap.tax.ok.gov/oktap/Web/_/). The link is not live yet, but it will be at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16, 2026.

**Q: What will the application look like?**

**A:** The state has put together very helpful videos [here](#). The general application video is about 10 minutes long, I highly recommend that you watch it as it walks you through the application step by step. This way, if you have any questions, you can ask them PRIOR to the application opening. Although the majority of our families will only need the "general application walkthrough video" below, there are other videos that explain different circumstances all are linked here:

**Q: What information do I need to have ready for the application?**

**A:** The OTC site has a very helpful infographic with all of this information: [Parental Choice Tax Credit Taxpayer Application Infographic](#)

If you wish to apply for more than one student, you will need to complete an application for each individual student.

• The following information is needed to complete your application:

- *Enrollment Verification Number*
- *Personal Information*
- *Parental Consent Form (if applicable)*
- *Student Information*
- *Federal Adjusted Gross Income*
- *Case Number/Member ID and Confirmation of Benefits (if applicable)*

• Failure to provide the required documentation or providing inaccurate information will result in denial of your application. The resubmission date and time of a complete application will determine your application's place in line.

• Taxpayers must provide the student's parent or legal guardian's Federal Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) for the second preceding tax year. For example, if you are applying for the Parental Choice Tax Credit for school year 2026-2027, you will provide the Federal AGI from tax year 2024, not tax year 2025. You may be required to provide a copy of the 2024 Oklahoma income tax return or federal income tax return.

**Q: Do I fill out a separate application for each student?**

**A:** Yes, it is one application per student. Each EVN is unique to each student. Please make sure you include the correct EVN with the corresponding student's application. Switching the EVN's by mistake could result in the denial of your application.

**Q: I have the EVN email, what do I do next?**

**A:** You must review the information on the EVN for accuracy, even the smallest error could result in losing your "place in line," as the PCTC is a first come first serve basis, within the

priority windows. If the information is accurate, then print this paper and have it ready for the application on March 16, 2026.

**Q: I did not receive the EVN email (for one or all of my students), what should I do?**

**A:** Please check all emails you could have used as the primary parent last year. Please also check your spam and junk folders. The sender is [parentalchoice@tax.ok.gov](mailto:parentalchoice@tax.ok.gov)

**Q: What are the steps in applying for the 26/27 PCTC?**

**A:** Please see this [infographic](#) from the state.

On Monday, March 16, 2026, at 9:00 am, the link on the PCTC website will open up. Parents will log on and complete one (1) application per student. It is IMPERATIVE that you log on right at 9:00 a.m. as the completion time of this application will be your “place in line” when the process gets to the first-come first-served section.

**Q: Where can I find more information?**

**A:** [The Parental Choice Tax Credit website](#) is full of information and resources. Their email address is [parentalchoice@tax.ok.gov](mailto:parentalchoice@tax.ok.gov).

### **Application Window:**

Applications with a priority status will be reviewed during the priority period.

- The priority period is 60 days from the application open date, March 16, 2026, at 9 a.m. through June 15, 2026, at 9 a.m.
- Priority applicants are those with a Federal Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$150,000 or less.
- Priority applications will be reviewed and notified of application status within 30 days from the date of the submission.

After all priority applications submitted during the priority period have been reviewed and a final determination is made, all other applicants can expect to be notified of their status

within approximately 30 days of the priority period ending or within 30 days of application submission if submitted at a later date. Please note, each application is unique, and as such, a manual review may be conducted to ensure accuracy.

**Q: How can I find out the status of my application?**

Upon submission, taxpayers will receive an email confirming receipt of the application. Please note, that it could take up to six hours to receive the confirmation email due to the high volume of applications. The application will go through the following steps:

- Verification that the application was filled out completely.
- Verification of student's parent/legal guardian's Federal Adjusted Gross Income (AGI), if applicable.
- Verification of the income-based government benefits including Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or SoonerCare/SoonerSelect, if applicable.
- Verification of documentation provided on the application, if applicable.

Once verification has been completed, the taxpayer will be notified of the status of the application via email. Taxpayers may also view the status of the application online at [OKTAP](#).



# INTRODUCING OUR NEW APP

# Summer Kids Club

Summer KIDS CLUB 2026 is open to any CK student who has completed one year of ALL DAY PreK through students entering 5<sup>th</sup> grade. We are partnering with a few of the teachers who will be having camps to provide a safe environment for your child's entire day. We will be offering our program on a week-by-week basis, running for the first 4 weeks of June, closing the week June 29<sup>th</sup> for July 4<sup>th</sup> and then reopening again on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July and running those next two weeks of July. Our last day being the 17<sup>th</sup>. The price for each weekly camp will be different and is listed below.

We **WILL NOT** be accepting Venmo. **Payments can be made only by cash or check.**

**Enrollment forms due by March 30<sup>th</sup>**

**Session 1:** June 1—5 VBS/Helping Our CK Community

All children who enroll for this week will be attending VBS. You will sign them up and pay for it at the time of registration. VBS is a camp this year from 9am to Noon each day. Registration for VBS is available on the church website. The cost for before and after care is \$180.00 per child. Checks for before and after care must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB and given to KIDS CLUB staff.

**Session 2:** June 8—12 CK News

All children who enroll this week will be attending CK News Camp with Mrs. Cheek. All of you will have the opportunity to watch the weekly broadcasts of our own CK NEWS. Our campers will spend the week compiling a SUMMER broadcast of the CK NEWS. Students will film news stories while learning how to use our equipment. They will host a "magazine style" news program. On Friday we will premiere the film before sending it out to our CK community. We look forward to our youngest newscasters' points of view. Our very own Junior High Science teacher Mrs. Lassiter will be joining us for our second annual Kids Club Science Camp. Biology, Physics, Chemistry, oh my! Come join us as we explore science in the world around us! Chemical reactions, engineering challenges, physical science experiments, edible labs, and much more will be part of the fun! The price for this camp, with before and after care included, is \$275. Checks are to be made out to CK KIDS CLUB. The hours for this camp are 9:00am - 1:00pm.

**Session 4:** June 22—26 Camp Kids Club / CK Pre-K and Kindergarten Summer Camp

2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> This camp will be run through Kid's Club. We will have some fun and different activities every day this week, specifics to come. This camp will cost \$275 with before and after care included. Checks are to be made out to CK KIDS CLUB. The hours for this camp will be 9:00am - 1:00pm

PK-1<sup>st</sup> The younger children from PreK and those going into first will have the opportunity to attend a week of Mrs. Pierce and Mrs. Smith's camp. We ask that you enroll your child with them. The cost for their camp is \$235. There will be before and after care available for \$150.00. Again, a check for the before and after care for your younger child must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Flyers from Mrs. Pierce have been sent out.  
The hours for this camp are 9:00am - 1:00pm.

## NO KIDS CLUB THE WEEK OF JULY 4<sup>th</sup>

**Session 5:** July 6—10 Bring on the Drama / Little Picasso's Art Camp

1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> The big kids will join Mrs. Cheek this week as the children will be given the opportunity to take part in a play. We choose a play, the children try out for parts (everyone is given a part), we learn our lines, design a set and then perform the play for our parents and others on Friday afternoon. This has always been a very fun week!! The cost for this week is \$275.00 per child, this includes before and after care. You will write a check directly to CK KIDS CLUB for this week.  
The hours for this camp are 9:00am - 2:00pm.

PK-Kinder Megan Wilson (PreK teacher) is having an art camp geared towards PreK (and those going into kindergarten) students. Children will be recreating some famous works of art and learning about the artists who created them. This camp is from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. The cost is \$225.00. There will be before and after care available for \$150.00. Checks must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Flyers from Ms. Wilson will be sent out soon.

**Session 6:** July 13—17 Our Lady of the Lake / CK PreK and Kindergarten Summer Camp

2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Lake Camp has returned! We are partnering with Bishop John Carroll for this week. This week the big kids (1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> graders) will be venturing to Our Lady of the Lake lodge in Guthrie. The campers will embark on an unforgettable week filled with excitement and discovery. This week only a few spots are available so you will need to act fast. The cost for this camp is \$275 with before and after care included. Please reach out to me about details for this week.

PK-1<sup>st</sup> The younger children from PreK and those going into first will have the opportunity to attend another week of Mrs. Pierce and Mrs. Smith's camp. We ask that you enroll your child with them. The cost for their camp is \$235. There will be before and after care available for \$150.00. Again, a check for the before and after care for your younger child must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Flyers from Mrs. Pierce have been sent out.

**Kids Club Before and After Care:**  
**Monday through Friday 7:30 am to 5:30 pm**

Other activities will include crafting, playtime inside the gym and outside on the playground. We have water play, reading time, and game time. There will be a rest/nap time for the younger children in Preschool and Kindergarten. Doors open at 7:30am for before care. We will not be letting anyone in beforehand as we will be getting the day ready. Anyone picked up after the 5:30pm pickup time will be charged \$5 per minute, same as our normal Kids Club rule.

There is a one-time registration fee of \$90.00 per child. This saves a space for your child. The registration fee goes toward supplies for our activities. The fee is required regardless of if you come one week or all weeks and is non-refundable.

Enrollment forms due by March 30<sup>th</sup>, payments can be paid by cash or check made out to CK KIDS CLUB. NO VENMO for Kids Club payments. Payments for the different sessions will be made either by online registration or to the camp leader. Before and after care payments are to be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Payment for the 1<sup>st</sup> session is due May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Each additional sessions payment will be paid by cash or check on the Monday before each session (2<sup>nd</sup> session payment due June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> session on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> session payment due June 16<sup>th</sup>, etc.) If you need to make other financial arrangements, you **must** contact Jill Hardin. Please turn your enrollment form and check into us ASAP. Space is limited to 25 students, so to secure your spot you must return it promptly. **Your spot WILL NOT be saved WITHOUT the registration fee.**






