#### Full day Preschool Students


- Drop-off: 7:35 8:00 a.m.

## ELMHURST DROP-OFF (MAIN SOUTH LOT)



Families with YOUNGEST sibling in 2nd grade or below




- Enter lot by turning **LEFT ONLY** into the West Entrance. NO right turns.

## GUILFORD DROP-OFF (NORTH SIDE)


