



Full day Preschool Students



ELMHURST DROP-OFF (MAIN SOUTH LOT)



- Families with **YOUNGEST** sibling in 2nd grade or below




- Enter lot by turning **LEFT ONLY** into the West Entrance. NO right turns.

GUILFORD DROP-OFF (NORTH SIDE)



GUILFORD PICK-UP (NORTH SIDE)



JR. HIGH DROP-OFF


