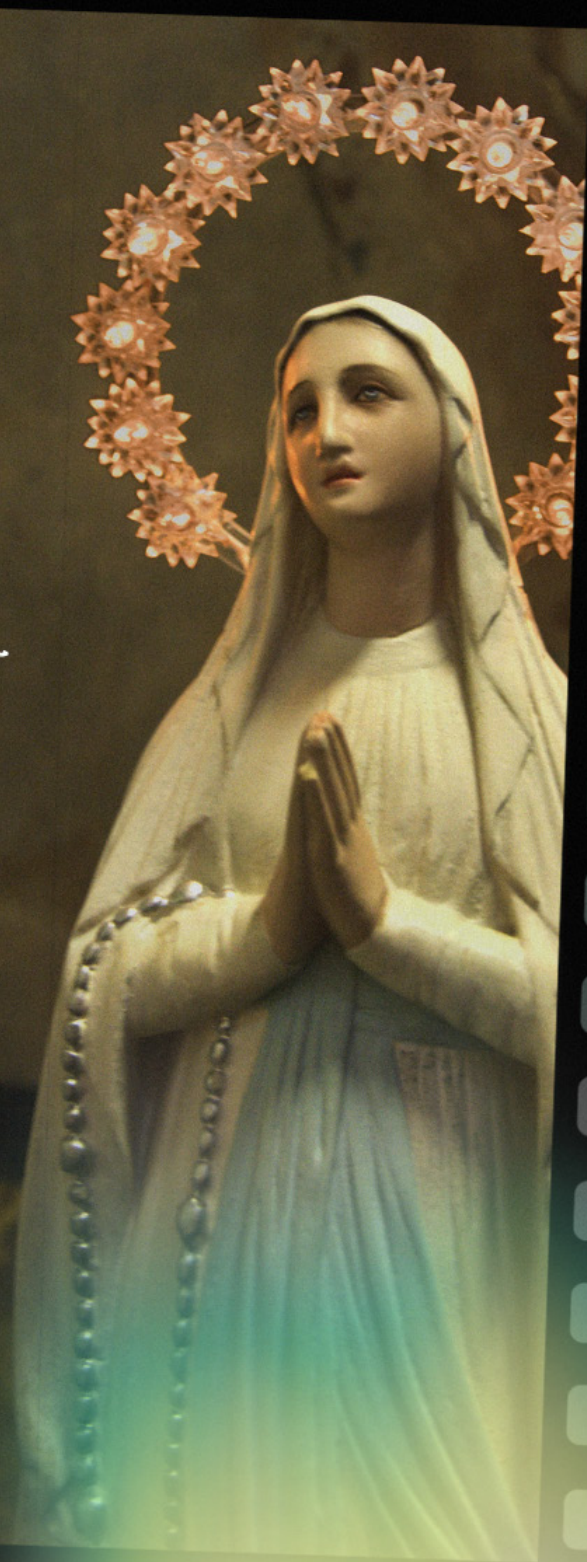

Beginning October 6, 2025, Christ the King School will begin using an integrated version of the FACTS Tuition Management and FACTS SIS systems. As of this date you will access your FACTS account via FACTS Family Portal. You will find the Family Portal link on the school website or by following the steps below:

FACTS Family Portal Login Instructions

- Please go to the website <https://www.factsmgt.com/>
- Top Right on the site, click on **"Log In Here"** by Parents & School Administration
- In the "For Pre-K-12 Families" box click on **"Family Portal Login"**
- Enter the District Code (CK-OK)
- If you already have an account, enter username and password and click Login.
- Click **"Create New Account"** if you have not set this up yet
- Enter the email address that received this email, and our District Code

Our District Code is **CK-OK**

- You will receive an email from SIS Customer Support containing a link that will allow you to create your username and password. For security purposes the link will remain active for six hours.
- Please click on the link. A **Change/Create Password** screen will open. You may use the default username provided, or create a new username. Then type in your desired password into the Password field and Confirm Field
- Click on the **Save Username and/or Password** button
- Close the window.
- Log into **FACTS Family Portal** as instructed above
