Carpool Reminders:

- Walk-up will now be located on the northside of school (off Guilford) by the East door (Mother's Day out door). A teacher on duty will wait with walk-up students until they are picked up by parents/caregivers.
- A reminder that walk-up is for students who walk home with a parent/caregiver.
- Southside drop-off (Elmhurst) - there is **NO LEFT TURN after 7:50**. The carpool line does not start back up until about 7:50 a.m., so the earlier you get here the better.
- Northside drop-off (Guilford) - students may NOT exit the car until the car has pulled up to the sidewalk; no exiting cars on the grass.

Parents of students in grades K-5th will be welcomed, meet the new teachers, and head to classrooms (we are shortening the meeting time).

Directly After Meeting:

1st-5th grade parents will meet with teachers in the classrooms. Each session with the teacher will be 15 minutes long and there will be two (2) sessions. This allows parents to be able to meet more than just one teacher with families with more than one student within this grade level.

***Please do not bring your children. This is a meeting for Parents/Guardians.**

*Childcare available for children 4-years old and younger in the nursery. NO RSVP required.

*Green Team uniforms will be available in the gym between 5:30 - 6:30 p.m.



FACTS UPDATE

To All CK Families:

In an effort to make the collection of fees more convenient for all parties involved, the school, athletics department, Kid's Club, and Lunch Bunch are all moving away from taking payments be it by cash or check. All fees, excluding tardies which will still be handled by office staff, will be assessed through FACTS. Cafeteria billing will remain the same as well. Charges will be posted to the student's name. In the case of field trips if there is a fee for the parents who drive, that fee will also show under the student's name and could possibly be assessed at a later date than the charge for the student.

An invoice will be generated for the specific fee with a due date 10 days from the date of the invoice. Regardless of the type of plan chosen for the payment of tuition, the fee will still be assessed through FACTS. This is incidental billing. If your FACTS account has a zero balance because tuition was paid in full or semi annually and that specific semester payment has already cleared, you will still receive an invoice. For families on the monthly plan, invoice payment dates will only coincide with tuition payment dates if the invoice due date happens to be the same day as the tuition payment date and they will be two separate payments.

Please be aware that any unpaid fees will result in restricted access to FACTS as well as holds on report cards until the fees are paid.

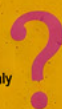

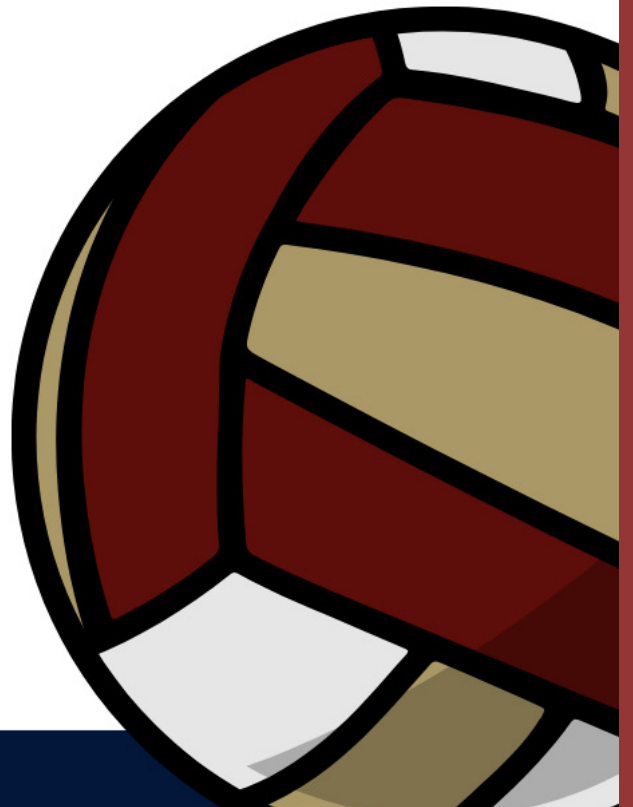

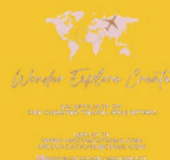

- Credit card and ACH payments can be made using the LUNCHTIME website portal as detailed above. Please note that online transactions incur small service fees via our provider and are outlined in the payment process.
- An auto-deduction option is included via the School Payment Portal. This feature will automatically draft funds when your account balance reaches a minimum level. This minimum level, as well as the replenishment amount, are determined by you.

EMAIL ALERTS

- Note that each student has his/her own account, so it is possible for you to receive multiple emails if you have more than one child. All notices you receive will pertain to one specific student.
- We will push out emails to this email address (or any other emails we have in our Contacts database for your account) when an account reaches approximately \$20. This should allow you time to replenish your account and avoid service interruption.
