



Goals of Catholic Baseball Team

Introduces players to teammates and potential future teammates @ MSM prior to High School Develop baseball skill and IQ to prepare players for High School – competitive scheduling Play with respect, integrity, competitive spirit, and sportsmanship

<u>Student Eligibility</u> Only students currently enrolled in CGSA junior high schools, or 8th grade students who have completed early enrollment at Mount Saint Mary High School are eligible to play on this team.

Costs and Fees

\$150 for new players: each player gets a home and away jersey top, and 1 hat \$125 for returning players who have uniform that still fit Checks can be made out to COF Junior High Baseball and sent to the first practice We need parent/volunteer help to run concessions and gate for home games Player fee and concession/gate income pays for umpires, concession supplies, and game balls

Parent Communication

Parents will be asked to provide cell phone numbers to be added to the GroupMe chat GroupMe will be used for all team communications

Practices

Weekly practices at MSM, two days per week (to be determined based on MSM field availability). Start late January. Practices may not happen during weeks of multiple games. Players MUST get practice repetitions outside of Junior High practices – we simply do not have time to get all the reps we need for each player

Practice and games with other teams (travel or rec league) is supported and encouraged Please keep coaches informed of arm usage with your other teams so we do not risk arm injury to any player (especially pitchers and catchers)

Games

A draft schedule will be emailed to parents as soon as it is completed (subject to change based on weather and other factors), expecting to play 18-20 games

Normal start time for games is 4:30 unless noted otherwise via GroupMe from coaches – please have players to the field at least 30 minutes before start time to properly warm up and prepare Typical game format = Varsity game (usually 4-5 innings) followed by JV game (usually 3 innings)

Junior High Rules

Each game is a coach's agreement for innings, game time, or run limits
Field Dimensions = High School size; 90' bases and 60'6" mound to plate
BBBCOR bats (-3 length to weight) must be used — you do NOT have to buy a bat, Junior High
Baseball has team bats that can be used

Uniforms

Each player receives 1 hat and 2 jerseys from the player fee.

Players need to be equipped with their own: glove, white baseball pants, navy blue socks, navy blue long under sleeves, cleats (metal or rubber), batting helmet, equipment bag, and warm jacket for cold days (to protect arm health).
