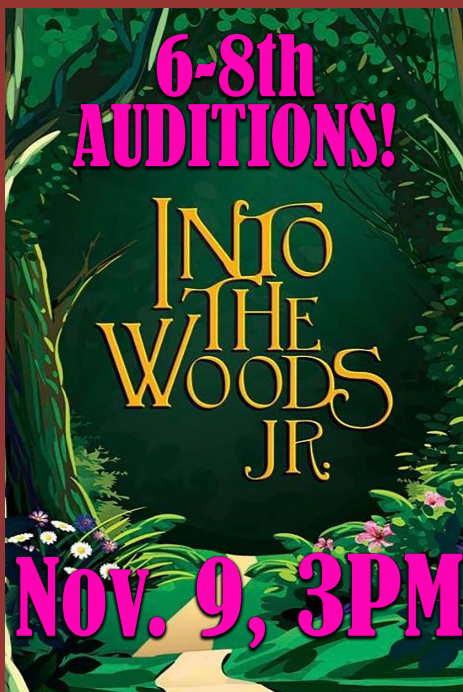
## EMPOWERED GIRLS MINISTRY
