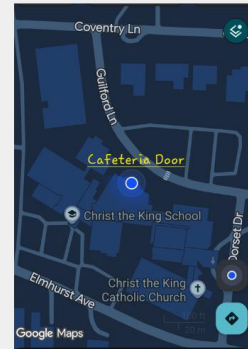

TECH CORNER FROM BEN TRACY

"How many of you play Roblox?" is the first question I ask in every middle school online safety presentation.

Nearly every hand goes up. Even in grades 3-5, about 75% of students are on Roblox.

Roblox is currently being sued by multiple state attorneys general for harm to children. A recent Nebraska lawsuit called it a "playground for predators."

Here's what parents need to know...

Roblox Is Not One Game

It's 6+ million user-created experiences, many not fully vetted. Kids can easily enter spaces with strangers, explicit content, or harmful language.

Predators Move Conversations Off the Platform

Grooming often starts on Roblox, then shifts to apps like Discord or Snapchat. Kids should never talk to strangers or move conversations elsewhere.

Constant Pressure to Spend

Robux drives in-game purchases. Many parents are surprised by charges tied to linked payment methods.

Parental Controls

Roblox does have parental controls, including chat filters, time limits, and spending caps. At Haven, we show parents exactly how to set them up.

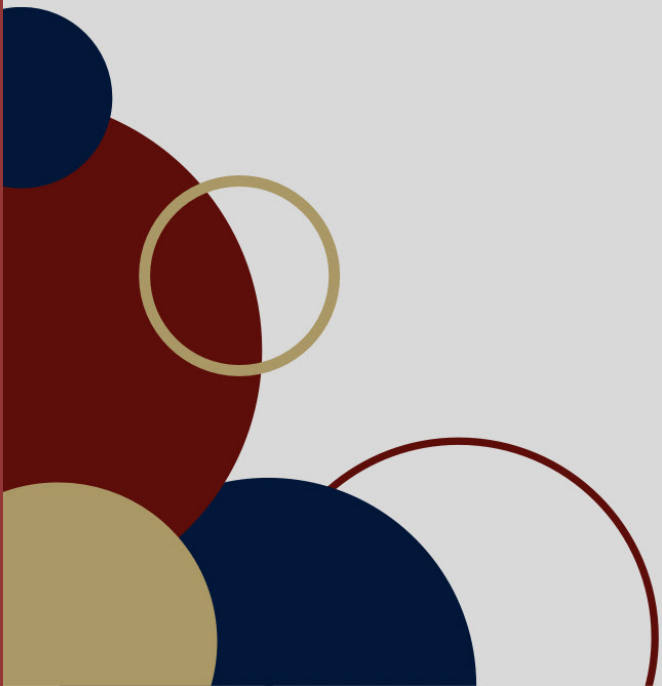

Summer KIDS CLUB 2026 is open to any CK student who has completed one year of **ALL DAY** PreK through students entering 5th grade. We are partnering with a few of the teachers who will be having camps to provide a safe environment for your child's entire day. We will be offering our program on a week-by-week basis, running for the first 4 weeks of June, closing the week June 29th for July 4th and then reopening again on the 6th of July and running those next two weeks of July. Our last day being the 17th. The price for each weekly camp will be different and is listed below.

We **WILL NOT** be accepting Venmo. **Payments can be made only by cash or check.**

Enrollment forms due by March 30th

Session 1: June 1—5 VBS/Helping Our CK Community

All children who enroll for this week will be attending VBS. You will sign them up and pay for it at the time of registration. VBS is a camp this year from 9am to Noon each day. Registration for VBS is available on the church website. The cost for before and after care is \$180.00 per child. Checks for before and after care must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB and given to KIDS CLUB staff.

Session 2: June 8—12 CK News

All children who enroll this week will be attending CK News Camp with Mrs. Cheek. All of you will have the opportunity to watch the weekly broadcasts of our own CK NEWS. Our campers will spend the week compiling a SUMMER broadcast of the CK NEWS. Students will film news stories while learning how to use our equipment. They will host a "magazine style" news program. On Friday we will premiere the film before sending it out to our CK community. We look forward to our youngest newscasters' points of view. The cost of this camp is \$275.00 per child, with before and after care included. Checks are to be made out to CK KIDS CLUB. The hours for this camp are 9:00am-2:00pm.

Session 3: June 15—19 Science Camp

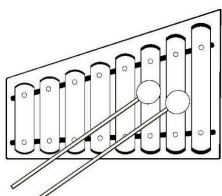
