

PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE



April 6, 2026

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Next week, each elementary Catholic school in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City will administer the Terra Nova NEXT and InVIEW, products of Data Recognition Corporation (DRC). The Terra Nova NEXT standardized test will be administered to students in grades K-8. The InVIEW, a cognitive abilities test, will be given in conjunction with the Terra Nova NEXT to students in grades 2, 4, and 6.

The Terra Nova NEXT achievement test is an online summative assessment that measures annual progress in both skills and knowledge. This test differs from the NWEA MAP formative testing that is given earlier in the year in that it measures overall achievement and aptitude for the grade level against a national norm base. Results indicate how our students in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma compare to students in other dioceses, districts, and private schools across the nation. They measure student performance on the national and college and career readiness standards framework and provide comparison data of your student with the national norm group. NWEA MAP is primarily a normed skills-based formative assessment based on state standards. It assists teachers in meeting the instructional needs of the students in the classroom by identifying where a student's strengths and weaknesses are as compared to a specific skill associated with a standard and benchmark.

The Terra Nova InVIEW is an indicator of aptitude and measures cognitive ability. It acts as a predictor for the Terra Nova NEXT, indicating if a student is performing to their potential. Scores from this test are statistically accurate for between two to three years. It is for this reason that we only administer it every other year up to sixth grade. It assesses cognitive skills such as understanding verbal and quantitative concepts and analyzing and comprehending relationships between verbal and nonverbal stimuli.

All of these assessments have their particular value and help our schools recognize student growth and development, identify intervention needs, drive curriculum and resource purchases, and inform professional development decisions.

Please encourage your child to get enough sleep and to eat a protein rich breakfast each day of testing and to do their best. There is no need to study for these tests. These types of tests measure one aspect of a child's development in school, the academic performance trajectory as related to cognitive ability. The child's spiritual, social, and physical development are also of significant importance. Development timelines in all these areas differ for each child. While we strive to offer our best to God, including academic excellence, we know that God has created each child in His image and that aspect of human dignity cannot be reduced to a test score. The Archdiocese of Oklahoma City does not participate in high-stakes testing where a child's grade level placement is dependent upon one standardized test grade.

Notice of changes to FACTS (formerly RenWeb) logins

FACTS (formerly RenWeb) has made changes to staff, parent and student logins so that you may be prompted to create a new username and password next time you log into anything FACTS or RenWeb related, such as the Family Portal, where CTK student grades and financial information is found.

What this means for you:

1. Your current login information should work the next time you log in, though after your next log in you may be directed to a page where you will be asked to make a new username and password for your FACTS account. For simplicity's sake, we recommend that usernames be changed to the email address already linked to your FACTS account. The FACTS system does not appear to be allowing most people to keep the same usernames as they have been due to security reasons with the multi-factor authentication feature they just added.
2. The password requirements have been changed and those requirements are shown on the page where you are asked to make a new username and password. A notable difference is that FACTS passwords must be at least 12 characters long.
3. For increased account security, FACTS recommends enabling multi-factor authentication (MFA), which you may be asked about the next time you log into a FACTS page for CTK. The simpler option is to select to use your email for this. You can delay adding MFA for now, but FACTS may eventually require it to be enabled. Choose your MFA option carefully, because it cannot be changed at a later time without deleting and re-creating your account, according to FACTS.

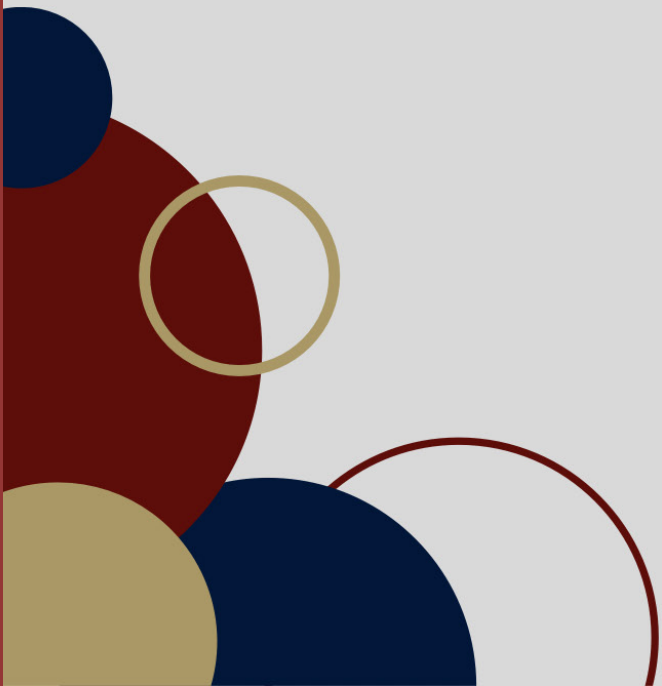

Due to the competitive level, there is no guaranteed amount of playing time. The recreational league is for players looking to just stay active over the summer. Teams will be divided into divisions separated for boys and girls and based on registrations, by age group. Per CCYO policy, all entries will make a roster.

Cost (installments available):

- First year - \$300 per player
 - Includes individually named uniforms and shooting jersey.
 - Covers team entry fees for tournaments, court fees, and officials fees (families responsible for travel and spectator door fees at tournaments).
- Returning players needing new uniforms - \$250 – Must use discount code R2026 during registration
- Returning players with uniforms - \$200 – Must use discount code 2026 during registration
- Freshman teams - \$100

Eligibility:

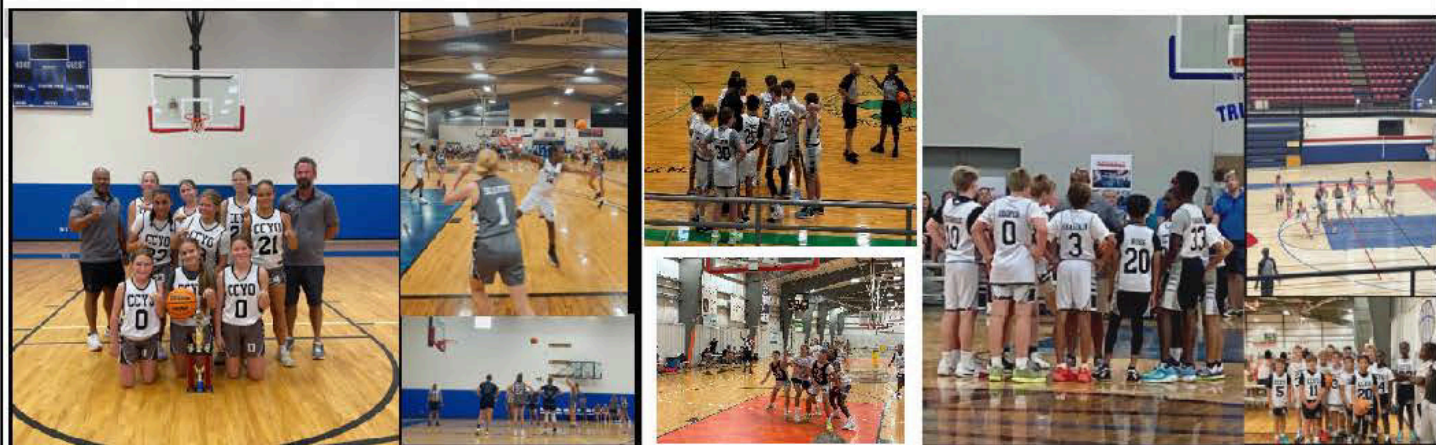
- Currently enrolled at a Catholic Grade School Athletic Association member school.
