## Meet-The-Teacher/Curriculum Night (K-5th)!

#### Wednesday, August 28, 2024

#### 5:30-6:00 p.m. Kindergarten Families

Kindergarten families go to your students' classrooms.

#### 6:00 p.m.: General Meeting in Main Gym

Parents of students in grades K-5th should make every attempt to attend this VERY important meeting. Students who have at least one parent in attendance will be able to have a special dress out day on **Friday September 8th.** If families purchased the Auction Sportswear pass then the child can wear sportswear that day.

#### **Directly After Meeting:**

1st-5th grade parents will meet with teachers in the classrooms. Each session with the teacher will be 15 minutes long and there will be two (2) sessions. This allows parents to be able to meet more than just one teacher with families with more than one student within this grade level.

## \*Please do not bring your children. This is a meeting for Parents/Guardians.

\*Green Team uniforms and CK spirit wear will be available for pick-up/purchase in the gym between 5:30 - 6:30 p.m.

### Just a few safety reminders for drop off and pick up. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO SHARE THIS WITH GRANDPARENTS/CARE TAKERS

#### Drop-Off:

- 1. All students MUST exit the RIGHT side of the car when getting out during drop off. Please make sure your child is able to open and exit the door on their own.
- 2. Elmhurst drop off: please enter the carpool line by making a RIGHT turn into the lot, so traffic doesn't get backed up; come down Elmhurst going west and turn right into the lot.
- 3. Elmhurst drop-off: after you drop your child and pull through, please make another RIGHT turn only to exit the lot, to keep the flow of drop-off moving.
- 4. Guilford drop-off, make sure to pull all the way up to the end of the sidewalk by the teacher to maximize the amount of cars that can unload at once.
- 5. ALL drivers are to remain in their vehicle at all times. (This does not include walk-up drop offs).

#### Elmhurst Pick-Up:

- 1. You MUST go EAST down Elmhurst and make a LEFT turn into the first entrance of the lot, NO right turns into the lot as this backs up traffic for the neighbors and thru traffic.
- 2. Please follow the cars ahead of you and fill up the row of cars from left to right first before making a new row. Make sure to pull all the way up to maximize the amount of cars we can get in the lot. If you are one of the first, we can usually fit 4-5 cars on the left of the pole and then 2 on the right.
- 3. If the lot is full and you are waiting in the street, you will need to be parked on Elmhurst or on the South side of Greystone where you will make a right turn down Elmhurst. Please do not make a line at the stop sign to turn left off Greyston onto Elmhurst.
- 4. A friendly reminder to make sure your child knows who is picking them up and in what car (or make a colorful last name sign for your visor too) so they can easily spot you as all parents are asked to please stay in your car. If your child needs help buckling up, please pull over after you are released from carpool to do so.
- 5. Please wait until all cars are loaded in the front row and the teacher gives you the thumbs up to exit.
- 6. Walk-up parking: please do not park along the side of Elmhurst by the parking lot or south. Park further east. Do not park in a handicapped spot unless you have a valid handicapped tag.

Those with Prek students and no older siblings, please remember to park in a parking spot (not in the main lot as cars will be using this to line up for carpool) and walk up to get your child from the prek doors at 2:45p.

#### **Important Reminders:**

- 1. Safe Environment Training: This is a training that is required by the Archdiocese to be completed by any adult that plans to volunteer with the students. Whether you signed up to do lunch/recess duty, a class party, in the future drive on a field trip, or anything else with the students, you MUST have this completed ahead of time. We are striving to have all our volunteers complete the training no later than Friday, Aug. 30. Click <a href="here">here</a> to begin your training. If you have completed the training before for another school, you must renew every year.
- 2. Membership Online Directory App: The membership app is our online directory. A great and easy way to look up students and parents and be able to contact them from your computer or phone. Each of you will need to <u>click this link</u> and set up an account for your family. When you do so, please make sure all the information is correct for your child, their grade and teacher.

#### **EX OFFICIO**

My name is Paul Lienhard and I am the current Chairman of Christ the King's Finance Committee. Many of you may be unaware that such a committee exists. The Finance Committee is comprised of appointed volunteers from the church and includes representatives from the Parish Council and School Advisory Committee. We meet on a quarterly basis to review the church's financial operations, assist in the annual budget process and discuss capital needs of the church's campus.

This letter is a follow-up to Fr. Rex's comments in the July 12th CK Crier regarding the Finance Committee and the role we play in analyzing the financial information of the church.

I would like to start with a discussion of our annual budget. I am sure you know that the largest source of our revenue is from the weekly offertory. You might have noticed in the weekly bulletin that we have not been meeting our offertory goal. In fact, in our last fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, our total offertory collected was \$2.7 million, which was \$100,000 lower than what was collected for June 30, 2023. Our goal when budgeting is to project break-even revenue minus expenses. For the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, we budgeted a 5% increase in tithing to \$2.85 million.

One fact that needs to be noted is we have sadly lost some of our most generous, long-time parishioners who were very faithful in their sacrificial giving. We will all need to step up to fill those very large shoes. Obviously, our school is a strong component for the growth of the church and both the church and school are well-served by this mutually beneficial relationship. Historically, the church budget has subsidized part of the school operations and will continue to do so in the future. With the new Parental Choice Tax Credit program, the subsidized amount will decrease but will not be eliminated. In addition, our school families will benefit from this program with reduced tuition costs. Not only does this allow more of our families to be able to afford Catholic education but it also gives them the opportunity to increase their weekly contribution to the church. A few years ago, we added the option to give your weekly offertory on-line through the Faith Direct program. This has been a good decision in many ways, but one negative, and one I've been guilty of, is not revisiting our giving on an annual basis. Due to inflation, the church and school costs increase every year. I challenge those who are enrolled in Faith Direct to look at your resources and see if you can make an increase to your current level of giving.

In conclusion, there is a business to the parish's operations, and we are not immune to the rising costs of operating such a campus. We are blessed with an incredible staff who meet the needs of our parish community daily while challenging themselves to be efficient with their individual budgets. We must also keep our salaries competitive to attract and retain individuals to lead our parish ministries and school.

Christ the King Catholic Church is a wonderful place to worship, create friendships and build community. We are fortunate to offer many ministries for parishioners to enjoy and grow their faith. However, we need to meet our income goals to continue providing the worthwhile ministries and programs that we currently offer.

Thank you for allowing me to give you an update on our financial status. This letter is not meant to alarm you, but to give you information and knowledge. This is our parish, and we all have a role to play in the continued strength of our church and school.
