### CK HALLOWEEN PARADE

On Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup> Christ the King School community will enjoy the annual Halloween parade. The parade will begin at 8:15 in the school gym and parents are welcome to attend. Students should come to school in costume. Please note the following guidelines for costumes:

- No masks allowed or headpiece that would limit visibility;
- If a costume is strapless or has spaghetti straps, then a shirt must be worn under it or a wrap/shawl can be worn over it;
- No gory, goth, racial, ethnic, political, or cultural costumes;
- No cross dressing;
- No toy weapons such guns, knives, axes, light sabers, etc can be part of your costume
- While we are easing the restrictions on group costumes, we are requiring that ideas for group costumes must be presented to all members of the same gender in the grade. While students may opt out of the group costume ideas, they must be included in the option to join the group.

We encourage students to change out of costumes after the parade. They will be able to wear a Spirit Day or Halloween-themed top for the rest of the day.






