



Dear Parents,

I am so excited to start the second year of CK Band! This year, Beginning CK Band will meet only on Wednesday's, from 3:00pm-3:45pm. This time is meant for 4th-8th grade students who want to learn an instrument. No prior experience is needed! The beginning band instruments your student has the opportunity to learn are Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone and Mallet Percussion. Band will start after school on Wednesday, August 28th 2024. We will be meeting in the new music room. Pickup will be in the school parking lot.

How does my student pick their instrument? We have (some) instruments that have been generously donated to Christ the King if your student would like to test out some of these they absolutely can during the first class time. We have a clarinet, trumpet, trombone, saxophone and percussion to test out at CK. We **do not** have a flute to test out. If your student would like to test out a flute I recommend going to Larsen's Music, they will definitely help!

Once your student has chosen their choice of instrument, we have a partnership with Larsen's Music where you can rent an instrument. I have a flyer that I will hand out during the first Wednesday that has instructions on how to rent an instrument from Larsen's Music. We have instruments available for use at CK, however I will let you know if there is one available from the school once I have all the instrumentation worked out. If your student already has an instrument they want to use from home they are more than welcome to bring that! The goal is for everyone to have their instrument/books by Sept.4th.

The book we are going to use is this method book: Tradition of Excellence (not Standard) – Book 1 (for YOUR instrument). A foldable wire stand will also be needed for band.

On the back of this sheet of paper is the Sign Up/Permission form. Please have your student bring this form back to me signed by a parent/guardian if they would like to sign up for the band. **Please have this turned in by Tuesday August, 27th.**





 - > \$60,000 with 1 or 2 dependent children OR
 - > \$70,000 with 3 or 4 dependent children OR
 - \$80,000 with 5 or more dependent children.

Special income provisions may apply to:

- Children adopted from certain court-ordered custody and children in the custody of court-appointed legal guardians.
- Taxable Social Security benefits based on the death or disability of the student's parent(s).

HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

- Graduate from an Oklahoma high school or homeschool education program.
- Take the courses required for college admission (listed at the right) and achieve at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA in those courses.
- Achieve at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA for all courses in grades 9-12.
- Attend school regularly and do your homework.
- Stay away from drugs and alcohol.
- Don't commit criminal or delinquent acts.
- Provide information when requested.
- Meet with a school official to go over your school work and records on a regular basis.
- Apply for other financial aid during your senior year of high school.
- Take part in Oklahoma's Promise activities that will prepare you for college.

If you don't qualify for this program, see your counselor for information about additional scholarships, grants and student loans, and visit Oklahoma higher education's college planning website at **www.OKcollegestart.org**.

COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

- Prior to receiving any program benefit in college, the federal adjusted gross income (AGI) of the student's parents may not exceed \$100,000. Each year in college, Oklahoma's Promise students will be required to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which will be used to determine whether the federal AGI exceeds \$100,000. For any year the AGI exceeds \$100,000, the student will not be eligible to receive the program benefit.
- You must be an Oklahoma resident.
- You must be a U.S. citizen or lawfully present in the United States.
- You must meet regular admission standards for first-time entering students at the college or university to which you apply.
- You must start taking college courses within three years after you graduate high school.*
- You may not use the award for noncredit remedial courses.
- You may not receive awards for more than five consecutive years after enrolling in college.*
- You may not use the award for courses taken after you complete your bachelor's degree requirements.
- You may not receive award payments for more than 129 semester credit hours unless your degree program requires more hours.
- You must meet the college's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy requirements for eligibility to receive federal financial aid.
- An Oklahoma's Promise college student who is suspended for more than one semester for conduct reasons will lose the scholarship permanently.
- * Students on active military duty may be eligible for certain waivers of these requirements.

of subjects previously listed or selected from: computer science, foreign language, or any Advanced Placement course, psychology, sociology or any concurrent liberal arts and science course at a state system institution
