PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE



August 21, 2026

Dear Knights:

We wanted to update you on an important calendar change in May 2027. The school recently found out that all diocesan priests, including Fr. Rex, will be on a retreat during the last week of May. The priest retreat, usually occurring after Memorial Day, was scheduled around the Archbishop's ad limina visit to meet Pope Leo. The retreat impacts several important school functions requiring Fr. Rex's presence, including 8th grade graduation. Accordingly, we have decided to use two weather days to move up the end of the school year. Please see these adjusted year-end dates below:

- May 17, 18, 19 - Junior High final exams
- May 20, 2027 - Field Day/last day for part-time students
- May 21, 2027 - 8th Grade Graduation Mass
- May 21, 2027 - final day for all full-time preschool classes
- May 24, 2027 - final day of school for Kindergarten - 7th grade; dismissal at 11:00 a.m.

The school still exceeds the required number of days even with preemptively using two weather days. This leaves several weather days to use if needed throughout the school year.

We are hopeful this 10 month notice will allow ample time for families to adjust their calendars accordingly. We appreciate your understanding as we navigate this unforeseen conflict. Please feel free to reach out with any questions. Thank you.

FACTS UPDATE

To All CK Families:

Incidental Billing Information

In an effort to make the collection of fees more convenient for all parties involved, the school, athletics department, Kid's Club, and Lunch Bunch are all moving away from taking payments be it by cash or check. All fees, excluding tardies which will still be handled by office staff, will be assessed through FACTS. Cafeteria billing will remain the same as well. Charges will be posted to the student's name. In the case of field trips if there is a fee for the parents who drive, that fee will also show under the student's name and could possibly be assessed at a later date than the charge for the student.

An invoice will be generated for the specific fee with a due date 10 days from the date of the invoice. Regardless of the type of plan chosen for the payment of tuition, the fee will still be assessed through FACTS. This is incidental billing. If your FACTS account has a zero balance because tuition was paid in full or semi annually and that specific semester payment has already cleared, you will still receive an invoice. For families on the monthly plan, invoice payment dates will only coincide with tuition payment dates if the invoice due date happens to be the same day as the tuition payment date and they will be two separate payments.

Please be aware that any unpaid fees will result in restricted access to FACTS as well as holds on report cards until the fees are paid.

ARCHDIOCESE OF OKLAHOMA CITY

Parish and School Firearms and Security Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to preserve parish and school property as safe, welcoming and orderly environments for worship, education, ministry and community life. Because these environments bring together clergy, staff, students, parishioners and visitors, security measures must be carefully controlled, professionally administered and consistently applied throughout the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City.

This policy establishes uniform standards governing firearms, dangerous weapons and security practices on parish and school property and at all parish and school-sponsored activities, in compliance with applicable federal and state law, including the Gun-Free Schools Act.

Scope

Except as expressly authorized by this policy, firearms and other dangerous weapons are prohibited at all times:

- On all parish/school property (owned, leased, occupied, or controlled).
- At all parish or school-sponsored activities, regardless of location.
- In vehicles on such property.
- On parish or school buses or any parish or school-sponsored transportation.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Churches, chapels and worship spaces.
- School buildings, offices and classrooms.
- Parish halls, offices and ministry facilities.
- Parking lots and surrounding grounds.
- Off-site locations of school-sponsored activities.

This policy applies to all individuals, including: clergy, employees, students, volunteers, contractors, parishioners and visitors. Parishes and schools will display the state-law required signage prohibiting firearms on the property.

General Prohibition on Firearms and Weapons

No individual may carry, possess, display or store a firearm or other dangerous weapon on covered property or at covered activities based on a concealed carry license, open carry authorization or any other private authorization under state law.

“Firearm” shall have the meaning set forth in 18 U.S.C. § 921.

“Dangerous weapons” include:

- Any firearm or firearm component.
- Knives, clubs, explosives, or other weapons listed under Oklahoma law.
- Any object capable of inflicting serious bodily harm.
- Any object used in a manner that could cause injury, regardless of its intended purpose.

Parish and school property are private property, and the archdiocese reserves the right to impose restrictions more stringent than those permitted under state law.

Prohibition on Volunteer Armed Security

Volunteer armed security teams or similar groups are strictly prohibited. No parishioner, employee or volunteer may carry a firearm in a security role unless authorized under this policy.

Unarmed safety teams may assist with:

- Hospitality and presence.
- Situational awareness.
- Emergency communication.
- Evacuation coordination.
- Notification of law enforcement.

Such teams must remain unarmed and may not present themselves as an armed protective force.

Authorized Armed Security Personnel

Armed security is permitted only under the following conditions:

- Only active, sworn law enforcement officers may serve in an armed security capacity.

- Officers must have jurisdictional authority in the location where services are provided.
- Officers must be employed and in good standing with a recognized law enforcement agency.
- Officers must have obtained any required departmental approval for off-duty or secondary employment.

All armed security personnel must be:

- Engaged as independent contractors (W-9 basis).
- Properly vetted and documented prior to service.

The parish or school must verify:

- Active sworn status and current credentials.
- Jurisdictional authority.
- Authorization for off-duty employment.

Consultation with the Archdiocese Security Office is strongly encouraged prior to engaging armed security personnel. All applicable insurance, indemnification and contractual requirements must be reviewed.

Automatic Exceptions

The only automatic exceptions to this policy are law enforcement officers in compliance with the Authorized Armed Security Personnel section of the policy:

- Law enforcement officers are authorized to carry firearms in the performance of their duties and must act in accordance with applicable law and departmental policy.
- Active, sworn law enforcement officers properly engaged in accordance with this policy.

No pastor, principal, administrator, employee or volunteer may independently authorize any individual to carry a firearm outside these provisions.

Requests for Exceptions

All requests for exceptions must be submitted in writing to the Archdiocese Security Office and approved in writing prior to implementation.

Exceptions may be considered only for retired law enforcement officers who:

- Separated from service in good standing.
- Possess official retirement credentials.
- Maintain valid legal authorization to carry under Oklahoma law or federal law (LEOSA).

Requests must include:

- Identification of the parish or school.
- The reason for the request.
- A description of the proposed role.
- Documentation of the individual's background, qualifications, and current firearms certification.

Approval is not automatic and will be determined on a case-by-case basis, considering training, experience, judgment and risk factors. Additional considerations concerning parish/school need and resources may also be a factor. All applicable insurance, qualifications, and contractual requirements must be reviewed by the Archdiocese Security Office. No individual may serve in an armed role without prior written approval.

School-Specific Requirements (Gun-Free Schools Compliance)

Student Conduct and Discipline

Any student who uses or possesses a firearm:

- At school
- At a school-sponsored event, regardless of location
- On school property or transportation

shall be immediately removed from school for safety purposes. Discipline may include expulsion in accordance with the school's handbook.

Students who possess other dangerous weapons are subject to disciplinary action based on the circumstances. Discipline may include suspension or expulsion in accordance with the school's handbook.

Students with disabilities will be disciplined in accordance with the school's handbook.

Employee Conduct and Discipline

Employees who violate this policy are subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination. Violations must be reported to law enforcement and the Archdiocese Department of Catholic Education and the Archdiocese Security Office.

Limited exceptions regarding dangerous weapons may apply where tools are used in the normal course of employment or where specifically authorized by the appropriate administrator.

Reporting, Confiscation and Law Enforcement

Any weapon discovered on parish or school property or school-sponsored activity should be reported immediately to the appropriate administrator, the Archdiocese Security Office and law enforcement.

If it can be done safely, the weapon may be confiscated and must be transferred to law enforcement authorities. All incidents involving firearms or dangerous weapons must be handled with priority given to the safety of all people present.

Administration and Enforcement

Pastors, principals and administrators are responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy across all parish and school operations.

Violations must be addressed promptly and handled in accordance with applicable disciplinary procedures and legal requirements. Questions regarding implementation, security personnel, signage requirements or exception requests should be directed to the Archdiocese Security Office.

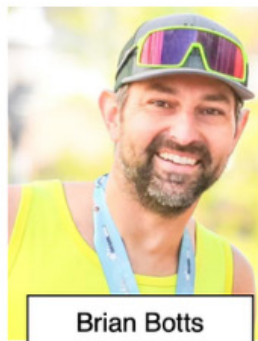
CCYO Junior High Cross Country
