ABOUT LIEUTENANT COLONEL TODD SCHERM



Todd Scherm is the B-52 Advanced Programs Systems Engineering Manager for the Bombers program at Boeing. In this role, Todd collaborates across the company, industry, and DoD enterprise to ensure his team's internal research and development projects are coordinated with customer priorities. His team is charged with developing mid- and long-term roadmaps and system architectures to ensure the B-52 remains relevant and viable beyond 2050.

Todd, who joined Boeing in 2015, retired from the United States Air Force as a Lieutenant Colonel after more than 20 years of service. As a B-52H weapons officer, he logged over three thousand hours in the B-52H. Todd served as an Instructor Radar Navigator/Weapons System Officer in operational, training, weapons school, and test squadrons, and deployed to the Pacific and Indian Ocean territories in support of Operations DESERT STRIKE and IRAQI FREEDOM.

He is a USAF Weapons School graduate and later returned as an instructor and Director of Operations. Todd's military career culminated with his opportunity to command the 49th Test and Evaluation Squadron from 2012-2014, executing operational test and evaluation for the B-52H. Although he considers himself a native of Oklahoma, his father was a USAF pilot and he grew up in NY, AZ, TX, CA, Okinawa Japan, and OK, where he moved for the last month of his freshman year of high school at BMCHS.

Upon graduation from the United States Air Force Academy with a bachelor's degree in human factors engineering, his USAF assignments spanned the following states prior to returning to Oklahoma after retirement: CO, TX, FL, LA, NV, AL, and VA. He also holds a master's degree in military operational art and science from Air University.

He is married to the former Stacie Donley of Columbus, OH and they have three children: Isabella, a senior at TCU; Aidan, a sixth grader, and Elise, a fourth grader, both at CTKCS.


