Summer KIDS CLUB 2023 is open to any CK student who has completed one year of ALL DAY PreK through students entering 5th grade. We are partnering with the Youth office and a few of the teachers who will be having camps to provide a safe environment for your child's entire day. We will be offering our program on a week-by-week basis, running for the 4 weeks of June, closing the week of July 4th, reopening again on the 10th of July and running the next three weeks. The price for each weekly camp will be different.

Session 1: June 5—9 VBS/Helping Our CK Community

All children who enroll for this week will be attending VBS. You will sign them up and pay for it at the time of registration. The cost for VBS has yet to be determined. They are holding a 5 day camp this year from 9am to noon each day. I will let you know when the registration is available on the church website. Each afternoon we have some service projects we will be doing for others in the CK community. The cost for before and after care is \$ 175.00 per child. Checks for before and after care must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB and given to KIDS CLUB.

Session 2: June 12—16 Bring on the DRAMA

Join Mrs. Cheek and Mr. Gillis this week as the children will be given the opportunity to take part in a play. We choose a play; the children try out for parts (everyone is given a part), we learn our lines, design a set and then perform the play for our parents and others on Friday afternoon. This has always been a very fun week!! The cost for this week is \$275.00 per child. You will write a check directly to CK KIDS CLUB for this week.

Session 3: June 19—23 CK CAMP / CK PreK and Kindergarten Summer Camp

BIGS This is the second year for CK Camp. During this week, the children in grades 2nd and above will have the opportunity to join in fun activities with Antonio Guzman (youth ministry director), Kat Edelen (4th grade teacher), Stephanie Hacker (5th grade teacher), Heather Shanahan (PE teacher), myself and the SUMMER KIDS CLUB staff as we share our faith each day through many fun activities. The cost for this camp is \$150.00 per child from 9 am to 3 pm. If you need before and after care that additional cost is \$100.00 per child. Registration is now open to anyone in the school community. There are limited spaces available, so register now.

LITTLES The younger children from PreK through entering 1st grade will attend Mrs. Pierce and Mrs. Smith's camp geared for PreK through 1st grade. We are asking that you enroll with them for your younger children. That cost is \$225.00. KIDS CLUB will offer before and after care for \$150.00 per child. Again, a check for before and after care for your younger child must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Flyers from Mrs. Pierce will be sent out just before Spring Break.

Session 4: June 26—30 CK ASK / CK PreK and Kindergarten Summer Camp

The daily activities will include skills training, tournaments, photo opportunities, and talk sessions on sportsmanship. The cost for this camp is \$150.00 per child from 9 am to 3 pm. If you need before and

after care that additional cost is \$100.00 per child. Registration is now open to anyone in the school community. There are limited spaces available, so register now.

LITTLES The younger children from PreK through entering 1st grade will have the opportunity to attend another week of Mrs. Pierce and Mrs. Smith's camp. We ask that you enroll your child with them. The cost is \$225.00. There will be before and after care available for \$150.00. Again, a check for the before and after care for your younger child must be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Flyers from Mrs. Pierce will be sent out just before Spring Break.

Session 5: July 10—14 Our Lady of the Lake Camp / Little Picasso's Art Camp

Everyone (both BIGS and LITTLES) will be involved. We look forward to our youngest newscasters' points of view. The cost of this camp is \$275.00 per child. You will write a check directly to CK KIDS CLUB.

Session 5: July 24—28 TBD

Hours: Monday through Friday 7:30 am to 5:30 pm

Other activities will include crafting, playtime inside the gym and outside on the playground. We have water play, reading time, and game time. There will be a rest/nap time for the younger children in Preschool or Kindergarten.

There is a one- time Registration fee of \$85.00 per child. This saves a space for your child. The Registration fee goes toward supplies for our activities.

Enrollment payments can be paid by check made out to CK KIDS CLUB. Payments for the different sessions will be made either by online registration or to the camp leader. Before and after care payments are to be made payable to CK KIDS CLUB. Payment for the 1st session is due May 23. Each additional session payment will be paid by check on the Monday before each session (2nd session payment due June 5, 3rd session on June 12, 4th session payment due June 19, etc. If you need to make other financial arrangements, you must contact me. Please bring your enrollment form and check into us ASAP. Space is limited to 35 students, so to secure your spot you must return it promptly. Your spot WILL NOT be saved WITHOUT the registration Fee.
