

INTRODUCING OUR NEW APP

We are excited to announce that our school has officially launched a new app designed to make staying connected easier than ever! The app is called Christ the King School OKC and is available to download in both the Apple App Store for iPhone and iPad, as well as for Android devices through the Google Play store.



This app will serve as a one-stop hub for parents with currently-enrolled students with important school information, including access to grades, financials, announcements, the directory and more, all in one convenient place. Our goal is to streamline communication and provide families with quick, easy access to everything you need to stay informed and engaged right from your phone.

While we will continue using email, our weekly Knightly Newsletter, and text messaging for important information, the app will serve as a convenient central location to find everything in one spot. We are aware that some parents have downloaded the generic FACTS family portal app to view grades - however, we ask that everyone download our new CK app as this will be the one we will keep current.

This app is a relatively new offering from FACTS and features will be changed or added as time goes on, but we believe this will make your experience with our school feel more organized, efficient, and connected. Please see below for download instructions, and we look forward to hearing your feedback!

How to get the CK App:

Click on this link for a shortcut to download the app.

Click on the Apple for the iPhone/iPad app or the Android icon on the right for Android phones (Samsung, LG, Google, etc.)

The first time you open the app, you will receive a text "Hi, this is CK School! Click here to verify your profile:..." please make sure you do this.

Also, please make sure to ACCEPT/ALLOW NOTIFICATIONS after opening the app for the first time so you don't miss important push alerts.

Once inside the app, you'll see buttons such as Newsletter, Spirit Shop, Athletics, etc. These link to our school website, where certain pages are secured with our password: AveMaria77.

Other buttons such as Financials, Directory, and Grades connect to the FACTS Family Portal. You will need the login credentials you created during our new online registration process to access these areas.

FACTS District Code: CK-OK

Then enter your FACTS login credentials.

Thank you for your continued support as we work to improve communication for our school community! If you need help or have questions about using the app, I would recommend we set up a time to meet in person so I could get eyes on what's happening on your phone - I can even meet right before or after carpool in the morning and afternoon! 8th grade girls won 1st in the consolation bracket!




7th grade girls won 1st place and 7th grade boys won 3rd place!
