Dear Parents:

Christ the King Catholic School's administration and staff are already looking ahead and making plans for next school year. In preparation for the start of the 2026-2027 school year, please take time now to complete your student's re-enrollment at Christ the King School.

Instead of enrollment packets, families will re-enroll through the FACTS family portal. While most of this process will take place online, we still require the Family Facts Sheet be turned into the office in order to count your family's enrollment as fully complete. **Online re-enrollment will need to be completed and the Family Facts Sheet will need to be turned into the office by Friday, February 13th.** In the event the school does not receive your family's re-enrollment by Friday, February 13th, we will assume that you are not returning to Christ the King and we will look to the waitlist.

Please note that payment plans will not automatically roll over for the 2026-2027 school year. During the online re-enrollment process, families will be prompted to choose their payment plan for the next school year. Re-enrollment fees for the 2026-2027 school year are \$300/student for returning students.

To complete our online re-enrollment process, you will access our Family Portal through your existing login. If you do not have a login, please follow the [Instructions for Creating a Family Portal Login](#) listed below. Students who have holds for outstanding tuition, fees, or fines will not be allowed to re-enroll until the outstanding balances are paid in full.

Our Enrollment system will open with a link to the enrollment packet for your child(ren). The process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later. If you have any questions, please contact our office.

GroupMe will be used for all team communications.

Practices

Weekly practices at MSM, up to two days per week (to be determined based on MSM field availability). Start late January to early February. Practice may not happen during weeks of multiple games.

Players MUST get practice repetitions outside of Junior High practices – we simply do not have time to get all the reps we need for each player

Practice and games with other teams (travel or rec league) is supported and encouraged

Please keep coaches informed of arm usage with your other teams so we do not risk arm injury to any player (especially pitchers and catchers)

Games

A draft schedule will be posted to GroupMe as soon as it is completed (subject to change based on weather and other factors), expecting to play 15-20 games

Normal start time for games is 4:30 unless noted otherwise via GroupMe from coaches – please have players to the field at least 45 minutes before start time to properly warm up and prepare. Typical game format = Varsity game (usually 4-5 innings) followed by JV game (usually 3 innings)

Junior High Rules

Each game is a coach's agreement for innings, game time, or run limits

Field Dimensions = High School size; 90' bases and 60'6" mound to plate

BBBCOR bats (-3 length to weight) must be used – you do NOT have to buy a bat; Junior High Baseball has team bats that can be used.

Uniforms

Each player needs to have 1 hat and 2 jerseys from the team store.

Players need to be equipped with their own: glove, white baseball pants, navy blue socks, navy blue long under sleeves, cleats (metal or rubber), batting helmet, equipment bag and warm jacket for cold days (to protect arm health). **NO METAL CLEATS must be turf shoes or molded cleats.**

Protective equipment (Athletic Cup) as required by High School rules. If they don't have one, they will not be able to play. The umpire will ask but obviously it will not be checked.
