PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE



August 28, 2026

Dear Knights:

We are off to a great start of the 2026-2027 school year and wanted to share the following updates.

Parent/Teacher Conference Day:

We are hosting parent/teacher conferences for classes on Wednesday, October 21, 2026. This is a day dedicated to conferences - there is no school that day. The nursery will be open from 8:00 - 5:00 for students 4-years and younger. No RSVP needed. We realize this conference date is adjacent to CK's Fall Break (Oct 19-20), but it is not part of fall break. Teachers have sent/will send their available conference times for you to sign up. Teachers' availability is Oct 21 & 22 - they will not be expected to stay late extra days past October 22nd.

There is a mandatory Professional Development day for CK faculty and staff on October 14 that was scheduled by the diocese. We realize this may be a hardship having a day off of school in the middle of the week and so close to fall break (which is the following week), and we apologize for the inconvenience - the scheduling was out of our hands.

CK Run:

I hope you will join us for the CK Run on September 12th. A big thank you to Lauren Dunlevy and Lauren Heinen for all of their hard work on this event. The run is so much fun as it involves the whole school and everyone in the family can participate. Please join us for this day of fitness, fellowship, and community!

Capital Campaign:

Last weekend Fr. Rex kicked off CK's ONE Faith/Family/Future Capital Campaign. Expanding Catholic education to our parish families has been a top priority, and became a reality this year with the addition of the St. Emmelia classroom. We are hopeful that the CK Annex is a temporary fix to the need for more room in the school, and that 100% of CK families will contribute towards the campaign. Every single one of us has benefitted from CK community members who came before us and built this beautiful school. Now it is our turn to carry on the legacy. An old proverb reminds us that, "A society becomes great when wise men plant trees in whose shade they may never sit." Thank you for your support of CK today and always.

CK Secures Grants:

We are pleased to announce that both Christ the King School and Church were awarded a Nonprofit Security Grant (NSGP) totaling \$400,000. We applied for the grant two years in a row, and were happy to have received this good news. Security enhancements will begin around campus soon.

In addition, Mr. Hackett (Physical Education teacher) secured a \$10,000 grant through Oklahoma State Department of Education's (OSDE) Competitive Grant for High-Quality Health and Physical Education Instruction. Mr. Hackett is already making CK a better place through his efforts!

Healthier Options at Lunch:

Benchmark has been working with the school to offer healthy options for "extras" during lunch. Rice cakes, hummus & veggies, and pretzels are some of the options. Juice boxes have been removed from the menu. Ms. Mary's famous big cookies are available on select Fridays.

Volunteers Needed:

We are in need of more volunteers for lunch and recess duty. This is a great opportunity to see your child in action during the school day and serve the school. There are two opportunities to attend his presentation: Sept 21 at 6:00 p.m. and Sept 22 at 8:15 a.m. CK is able to host this dynamic speaker for FREE due to the generosity of the PTO Wish List. Please make an effort to attend as Mr. Carone's message will be worth your while!

Growth Mindset:

During our faculty in-service this year, we discussed a growth vs. fixed mindset. Research shows that praising effort over achievement motivates students to attempt more difficult tasks, learn from failure, and not be afraid to try - all building blocks towards perseverance. 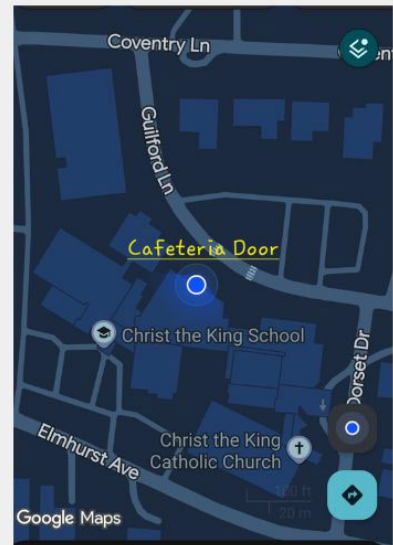

Rehearsals:

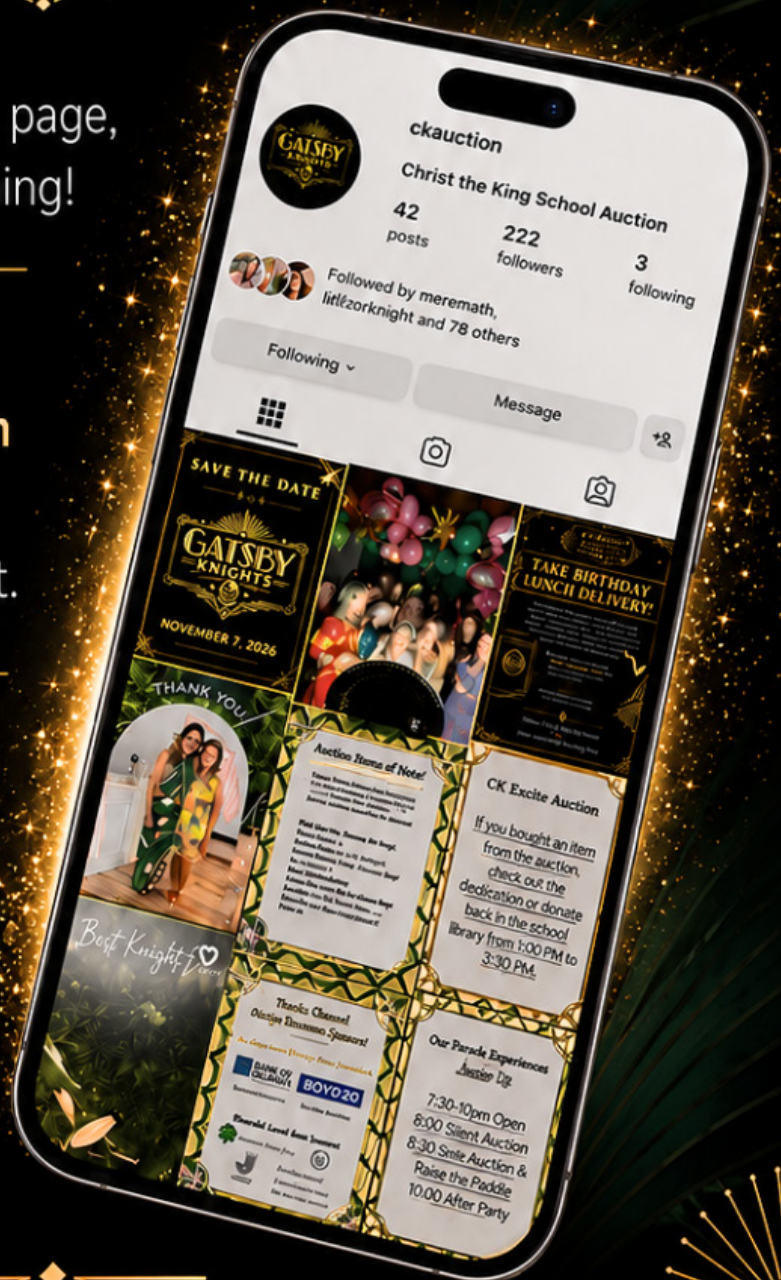

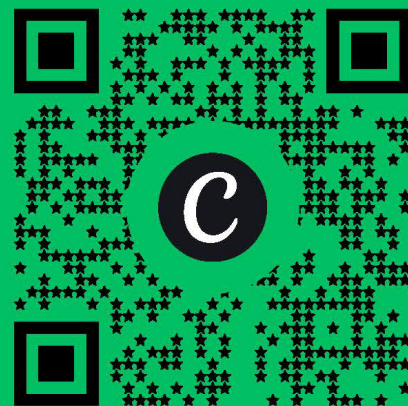

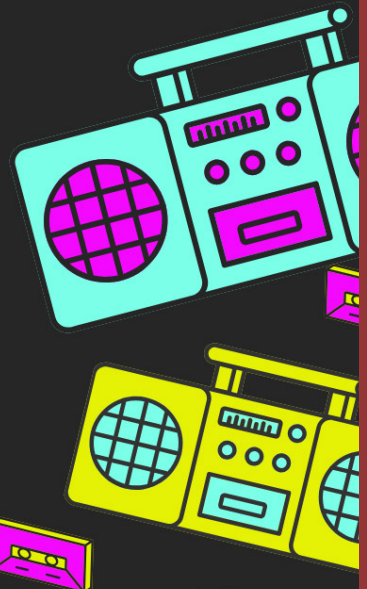
