Hello CK Families,

I hope you were able to stay warm during the cold weather these past couple of weeks. Oklahoma weather can be hard to predict, and temps can differ dramatically from day to day. We certainly have witnessed this in the month of January. This crazy weather did not stop us from having an awesome Catholic Schools' Week. Unfortunately, we missed out on a couple of events that we are rescheduling or hoping to reschedule. Decades Day will now be celebrated Monday, February 6th and we are hoping to reschedule Mass with Archbishop Coakley in the near future. We have reached out to his office and are hoping to get some dates that he might be available. It is always a special treat for him to celebrate Mass with our school community. We have also extended the canned food drive until Monday morning. The students in each class will build a sculpture of all the cans collected, and we will view and take pictures of those sculptures at the end of the day on Monday.

Although, there were some activities that were missed due to weather, there were still a lot that took place while we were in school. It all started with CK Saints Day. It was an awesome day! All students celebrated a saint by learning about him or her and dressing up as that saint. I was so impressed by the outfits and the knowledge that these students knew regarding these very important individuals. The creativity was awesome. I applaud all families, as I know this was a project that took parent help. Our Catholic faith was on full display that day. Students continued to do special activities in their classrooms throughout this past week celebrating Catholic Schools' Week. The week ended with the annual Catholic Quiz Bowl and Pie-In-the-Face. I had a parent say how neat it was watching these events, especially seeing the whole school community cheer and celebrate Christ the King students and teachers. We have never really publicized these events for all in the school community to attend. After hearing from some parents who were there watching their child(ren) in the Quiz Bowl, I hope that we can have more parents come and see all the fun and positivity surrounding these events. The Pie-In-The Face event raised a little over \$640.00 for the Juvenile Diabetes Organization. This was the organization that was selected by students, and identifies a worldwide organization. By giving to an organization like this helps the students know that Christ the King School makes a difference in the world community as well as our local community. The food donations will be helping both our parish community as well as our city community (Oklahoma Food Bank). Students also decorated bags for Sister BJ's Pantry - Hotdogs for the Homeless, and they wrote letters to individuals in the military to show our gratitude and appreciation for those who are helping to keep our nation safe. It was a short week due to weather, but it was still a very busy one.

I can't believe it, but it is time for pre-enrollment for the 2023/2024 school year. Just a reminder pre-enrollment fees changed last year, and we will continue with those fees this year.

Pre-enrollment fee for 1st child in a family - \$250.00 Pre-enrollment fee for the 2nd child in a family - \$200.00 Pre-enrollment fee for each additional child in a family - \$175.00

These fees help off-set tuition costs and pay for the operations of running a school. Packets will be sent home this week with your oldest child. Packets are due back at the end of February. We have a very large waitlist for prospective families wanting to send their child(ren) to Christ the King School. We will start contacting those on the waitlist as soon as pre-enrollment is complete. If your paperwork is not turned into the office by the deadline, we will assume that your family no longer needs spots at CK. If you do not receive a pre-enrollment packet, please contact the office. All accounts must be paid in full to receive a one. If you have a concern of an unpaid balance, please contact Vanessa Pierce. If payment of your pre-enrollment needs to be discussed, please contact Vanessa Pierce or myself. We understand this can be a large cost and the timeline to have it turned in is right around the corner. We will work with you.

The virtue for the month for February is honesty. Students will be discussing this in class, and we have already talked about it as a school community. Although this virtue is easy to talk about with children, it can be a hard one to follow sometimes, especially when a child thinks they might get in trouble for telling the truth. Unfortunately, adults can have a hard time with this virtue as well. It is our hope that talk about this virtue and others will take place in the home just as they do at school. If you need any resources to help with discussion in the home, please let us know. We will be happy to help.

In this month where the word love seems to be on display more than usual, don't forget the love Christ shows for us each day. We are so blessed. Let us remember the greatest commandment of all.
