PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE



Dear Knights,

This letter was sent on Monday, but please note the following **highlighted changes**.

During their review, the accreditation committee identified an area for improvement for the southside drop-off carpool procedures. Accordingly, effective immediately, we will make the following changes to SOUTHSIDE DROP-OFF:

Changes to Southside Carpool Effective Immediately (Preschool + 5th students):

- All preschool students (except for St. Jude students) will need to be driven through the line and dropped off (no more walking in preschool students to the drive-thru).
- 4th grade students can now be dropped off on Guildford to alleviate front traffic.
- St. Jude students will be the only cars allowed to park and walk their children to the exterior preschool entrance at 8:05 (as per usual - no changes);

Other drop-off locations:

A reminder that the southside drop-off is for Preschool students and 5th graders. Students not in those grades levels need to use the other carpool areas in which they are assigned:

Guilford drop-off = families with ALL students in **K-4th**

Junior high drop off - families with oldest student in Junior high

Front/southside carpool will definitely take longer as people adjust to these new procedures. Please make sure your preschool students can unbuckle themselves and get out of their carseats independently. All students must exit from the passenger side. There will be no other changes to any carpool location or procedure.

We have attached carpool graphics. We need ALL parents to follow carpool rules - there were several violations during the accreditation visit. Please do your part to keep our campus safe and secure for all students.

Dear Knights:

Christ the King School has received a number of complaints & inquiries into sporting teams formed outside of school affiliation. This seems to be occurring mainly in younger grades. We would like to make clear our policies & views on this matter.

- The school has crafted clear language on the formation of teams & use of the CK name and/or Knights logo (see handbook Section 22)
- The school has crafted clear language on the use of our facilities for practices, games, etc. (see handbook Section 22)
- The school has reiterated our philosophy that young students are in development during early childhood, and athletic abilities are not pre-determined nor established.
- The school has tried to instill a philosophy on inclusivity through these policies, and will continue to do so.

CK is involved in the oversight & implementation of CGSAA sports. The school does not compensate coaches or personnel for any sporting responsibilities, which are assumed voluntarily. For team formation outside of CGSAA, in which the school does not exercise oversight, we encourage all parents to embrace a spirit of inclusion & shared Catholic values, as these matters can cause a rift in the community.

The school is committed to the education of our students in the Catholic faith & preparing students for their futures. It is my hope & prayer that CK parents in the community will reach out & support one another & their children.
